		Fish appears bloated to the point of bursting. Scales become raised and stick out. The anus is often inflamed.	Dropsy	KanaPlex Focus
		Eyes protrude or appear to be "popping out" of their sockets.	Popeye	KanaPlex Focus NeoPlex
		Fins appear shredded, frayed, or decaying. Usually has white lining along fins	Fin & Tail Rot	ParaGuard NeoPlex SulfaPlex KanaPlex PolyGuard
		Thin white or gray threads appear; these build up their mass until they appear like patches of cotton.	Fungus	ParaGuard NeoPlex SulfaPlex KanaPlex PolyGuard
		Streaky or blotchy reddening appearing on the fins near the body or under the scales.	Bacterial Hemorrhagic Septicemia	NeoPlex SulfaPlex KanaPlex
		Ich: The fish appears sprinkled with grit or coarse sand. Fish rub against hard objects to free themselves of the parasite. Velvet: Surface appears dull and in heavy infections, the fish takes on a yellowish velvety texture.
